Minutes of Meeting -- April 10, 2013**

President Rick Johnson called the meeting to order at Charley's Restaurant at 7:30 p.m. and welcomed 23 members and guest Dorr Tucker. The minutes of the March meeting were approved as distributed with the addition of Peggy Deyerle as one to be thanked for helping at the C&OHS train show at Clifton Forge. Former secretary Lloyd Lipscomb agreed to take the minutes for this meeting. Treasurer John Tanner gave reports for March and April.

Under old business and announcements, Rick Johnson announced that Bob Chapman, Peggy Deyerle's brother, died in South Dakota. Rick announced that he and four others went on the hike to explore the location of the Franklin and Pittsylvania Railroad. The field trip to High Bridge State Park is being held on April 11. Participants will meet at the old Farmville railroad station, and help will be given to those needing a ride to the bridge. On Tuesday, April 16, at 7:00 p.m., at the Farmville station, there will be a program commemorating the 110<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the station. Norris Deyerle reported that the trip to the Virginia Museum of Transportation in Roanoke on March 17<sup>th</sup> was enjoyable. A contribution was made to the Roanoke Chapter to help defray the cost of the locomotive rides. Director Bev Fitzpatrick thanked the Blue Ridge Chapter for their continuing support of the V.M.T.

Under new business and reports, Earl Guthrow, national representative, said that he should be informed of members deserving a certificate and pin for long time membership in the NRHS, beginning with 25 years. Rick Johnson thanked Garland Harper for his editorship of the "Blue Ridge Dispatcher." Lee Hawkins reminded the group of the proposed May 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> circle trip with train trip between Richmond and Newport News and an overnight stay in Norfolk. The second day will begin with 6:05 a.m. train departure from Norfolk to Richmond. Some will then want to return by car to Lynchburg, and others may want to return by train to Lynchburg by way of Alexandria and Washington DC. If interested, please see Lee for details. It was reported that an obituary of former Blue Ridge Chapter member David Leonard was printed in the newsletter of the Binghamton, NY chapter. At the regular May 8th meeting Rick "Dash Two" Johnson will present the program. The Fun Night on May 22<sup>nd</sup> will include presentations by Dorr Tucker and Robin Shavers.

**David Leonard remembered again** - In January 2013, SVRHS member David Leonard (formerly a Blue Ridge Chapter member) passed away. David had transferred membership from an-other chapter in New Jersey in the early 2000s, and had attended many SVRHS meetings. He also had provided frequent updates on rail activity in eastern Pennsylvania and northern New Jersey, and was one of the contributors to our "member slide night" programs, with old and more recent views and narrative on northeastern railroad scenes and activity. David was a minister, and had numerous friends and acquaintances in the area; his stories and wisdom were well-received by all who knew him. Our sympathies go out to his family for this untimely loss.

## **Black Flags**

David Leonard, 71, died at home January 28, 2013, after a long entanglement with cancer. This occurred two weeks after he and his wife, Linda Wilts acknowledged their 46th wedding anniversary. David is also survived by a daughter, Elisabeth Anne Leonard and husband, Adam Hill of California, son, Marc David Leonard, of Oregon, three grandchildren, Benjamin, Jaden and Kaila. He leaves behind brother, Richard and Shirley Anne Leonard, sister, Lucy and Larry Hill, all of Illinois as well as many nieces, nephews and cousins.

David was born in Rutland, Vermont although his father's profession caused his family to move frequently. He graduated from Illinois Wesleyan University as a math major and went on to the Chicago Theological Seminary and was ordained a Methodist minister. It was there he met and married Linda Wilts who was also studying for the ministry.

It didn't take David long in the parish ministry to decide that the Methodist denomination was not a good fit for him and he became a Unitarian Universalist in the early 70's. He served churches in Pennsylvania, Virginia, Ohio, New Jersey and from 2002-2003 was interim minister at the Unitarian Universalist Congregation on Riverside Drive in Binghamton. His passions were photography, nature, and trains. David was a member of the Susquehanna Valley Railway Historical Society and was a Detroit Tigers fan. David loved animals, especially cats.

A memorial service was held at 4:00 pm, February 28, 2013, at the Unitarian Universalist Congregation, 183 Riverside Drive, Binghamton. Memorial contributions in David's name may be made to the Broome County Humane Society, 2 Jackson Street, Binghamton, NY 13903.

Children 12 and under are always admitted at no charge when accompanied by a paying adult. Vendors are encouraged to bring items that appeal to children. Many small children attend our show with their parents. Last year's attendance was approximately 500 adults and children. We have numerous door prizes and a raffle. Our very popular "White Elephant Table", where our Chapter sells individual's train related items on a consignment basis, always attracts sellers and buyers to our show. Model layouts with operating trains are a real treat for everyone young and old. The Lynchburg Rail Day 2013 facility is air conditioned and has wide aisles for easy access during the train show. We will still have our popular slide or video presentation by a Chapter member or friend. Our Model Railroad and Railroad Photography Exposition will continue this year. This gives railroad modelers and photographers a competitive environment to show off their work. Prizes are given to the winners of the numerous categories. Our Chapter also operates a concession stand with freshly prepared lunch items and snacks at very affordable prices. As in years past, the train show will be held at the Boonsboro Ruritan Club on 1065 Coffee Road just off of Rt. 501 North in Lynchburg, Virginia.

No refunds for tables will be given on or after July 10, 2013. Prior to July 10, 2013 table rental refunds will be given for personal hardships. To help boost your sales, at your request, we will post your name and any contact information that you supply to us on our Chapter website when your table reservations are paid in full.
